



Dear Caltrain Neighbor,

As part of the 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project that will improve safety for motorists and pedestrians, crews will begin AT&T utility relocation work as early as December 26. During the first week, crews will mobilize equipment near 31st Avenue and the railroad tracks.

Actual construction may begin as early as January 7, 2019 and will include excavation and sheet piling. Sheet piles are put into the ground to act as a retention system to support excavation. These activities are anticipated to last approximately two weeks. Work hours will be from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Neighbors may experience noise during these times. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

The 25th Avenue Grade Separation Project will raise the tracks and slightly lower the road (grade separate) at E. 25th Avenue in San Mateo. Caltrain, in cooperation with the City of San Mateo, is implementing the project to improve safety for both motorists and pedestrians, and to reduce traffic congestion and horn noise. In addition, the project will complete east-west street connections at 28th and 31st Avenues and build a new elevated Hillsdale Station with updated amenities at E. 28th Avenue.
