# REMOTE MEETINGS (AB 361)

- AB 361 allows the JPB to authorize remote meetings when state of emergency is in effect, public health authorities recommend social distancing, and the JPB finds that meeting in person would pose risk to attendees
- Resolution authorizing remote meetings allows JPB Directors to participate in meetings from remote location without noticing the location from which they participate

# RECOMMENDATION: Remote Meetings

- Adopt resolution authorizing JPB and committees to continue to meet remotely for the next 30 days
- Conduct April Committee meetings remotely but conduct May Board meeting in person, unless health conditions deteriorate, and require attendees to wear a mask

# HYBRID MEETINGS FOR PUBLIC

- Brown Act allows local agencies to permit members of the public to participate remotely once state of emergency expires
- Many local agencies plan to hold hybrid meetings by continuing to offer the public the opportunity to participate remotely once the agencies return to in-person meetings

# RECOMMENDATION: Hybrid Meetings

- Adopt resolution authorizing members of the public to continue to participate remotely after JPB and committees resume in-person meetings
