- On November 14, the Network Management Business Case Advisory Group (AG) received an update from MTC staff on a governance framework and operating model for Regional Network Management (RNM).
- MTC staff has proposed roles for operators and a regional entity in each of the six functional RNM areas:
 1. Wayfinding
 2. Fare Integration Policy
 3. Accessibility
 4. Bus Transit Priority
 5. Rail Network Management
 6. Network Planning

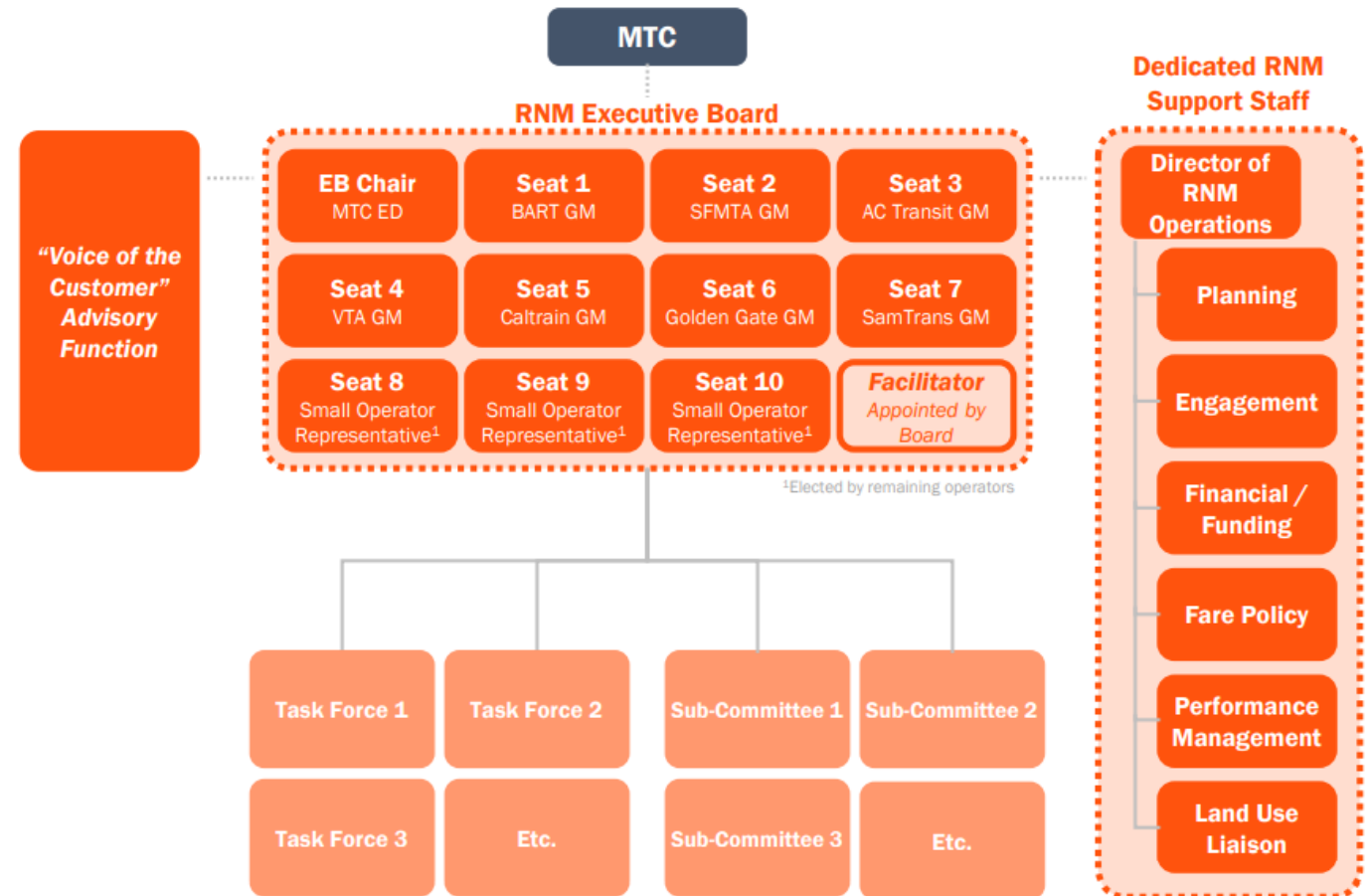


Regional Network Management (RNM)

- At the November 9 meeting of the Policy Advisory Council, MTC staff provided a briefing on near-term updates to the regional plan, termed Plan Bay Area 2050+
- Additionally, the Blue Ribbon Task Force's Connected Network Plan will transition into Transit 2050+, a subset of Plan Bay Area 2050+
- The goal is to have a regional plan that better reflects current transit ridership and revenue recovery levels.

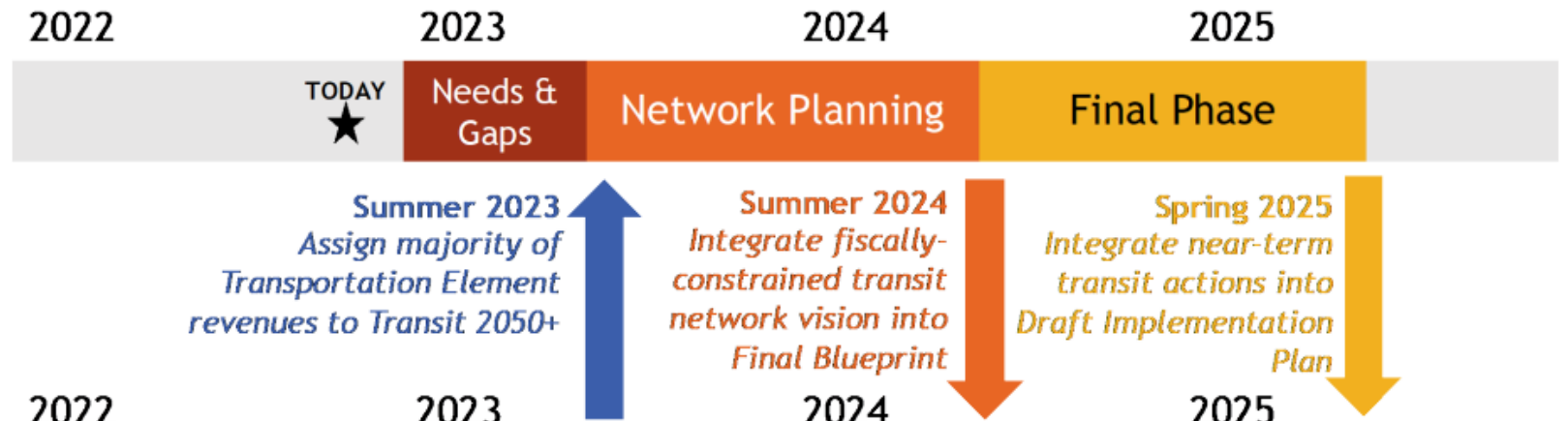
