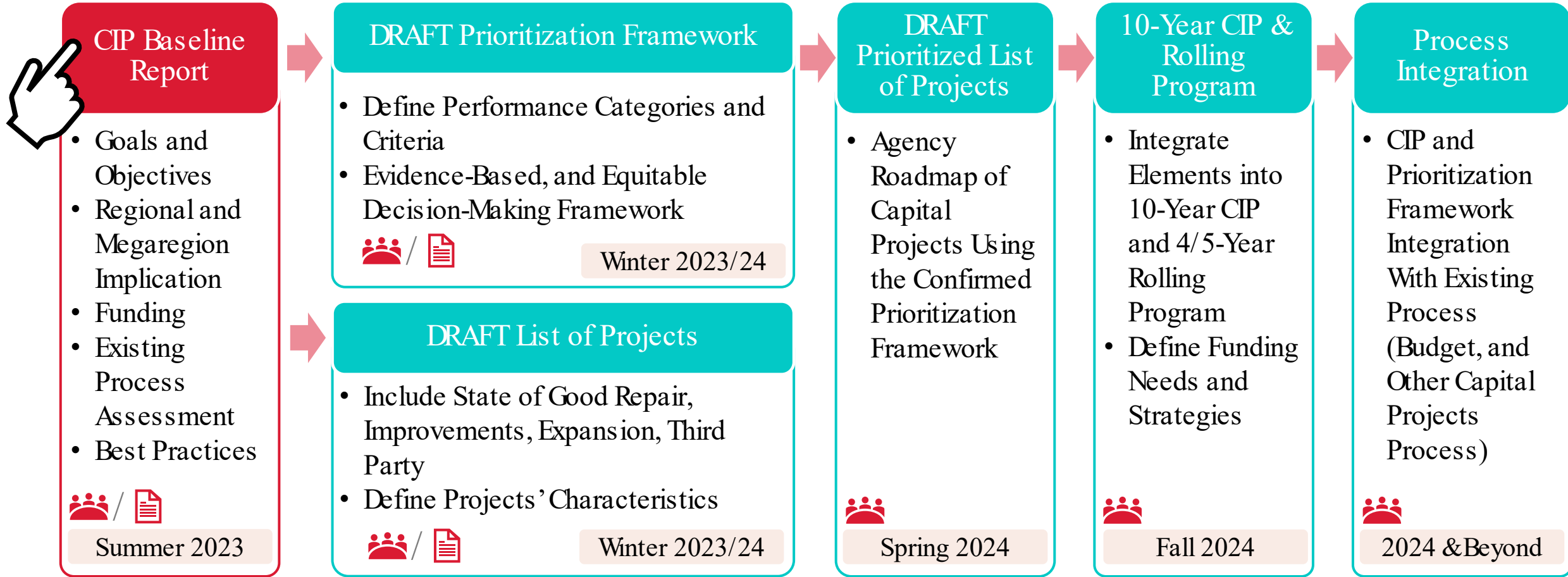

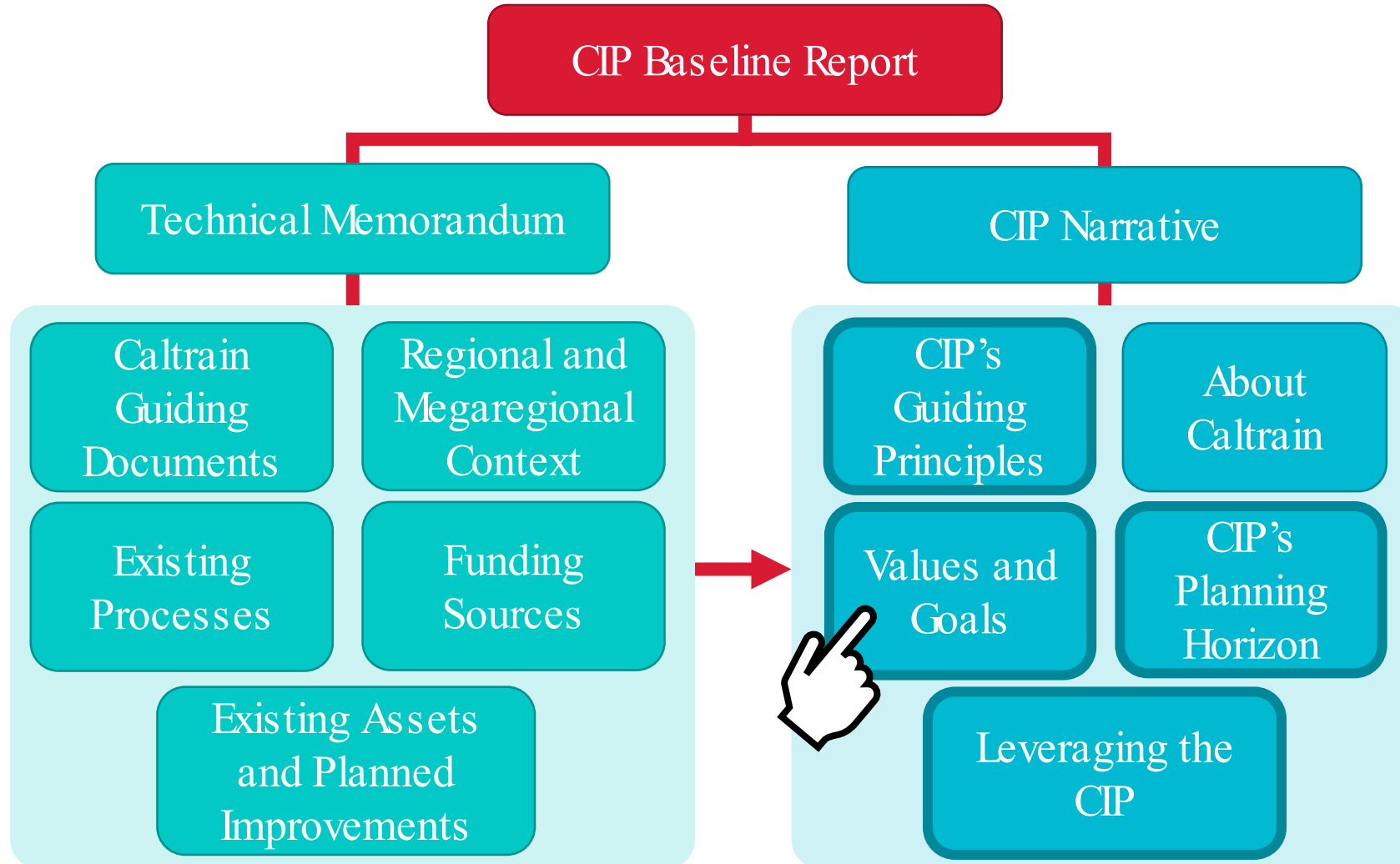

Caltrain enhances regional connectivity through an integrated transit network.

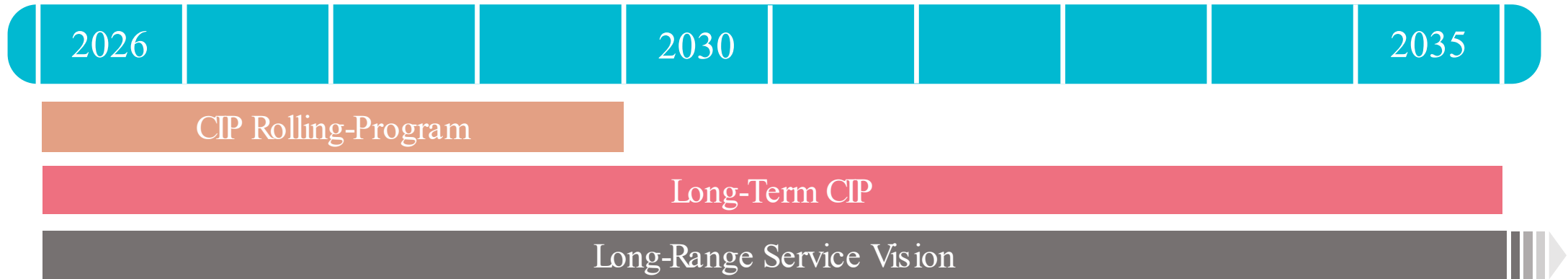
## Livability

# CIP's Planning Horizon



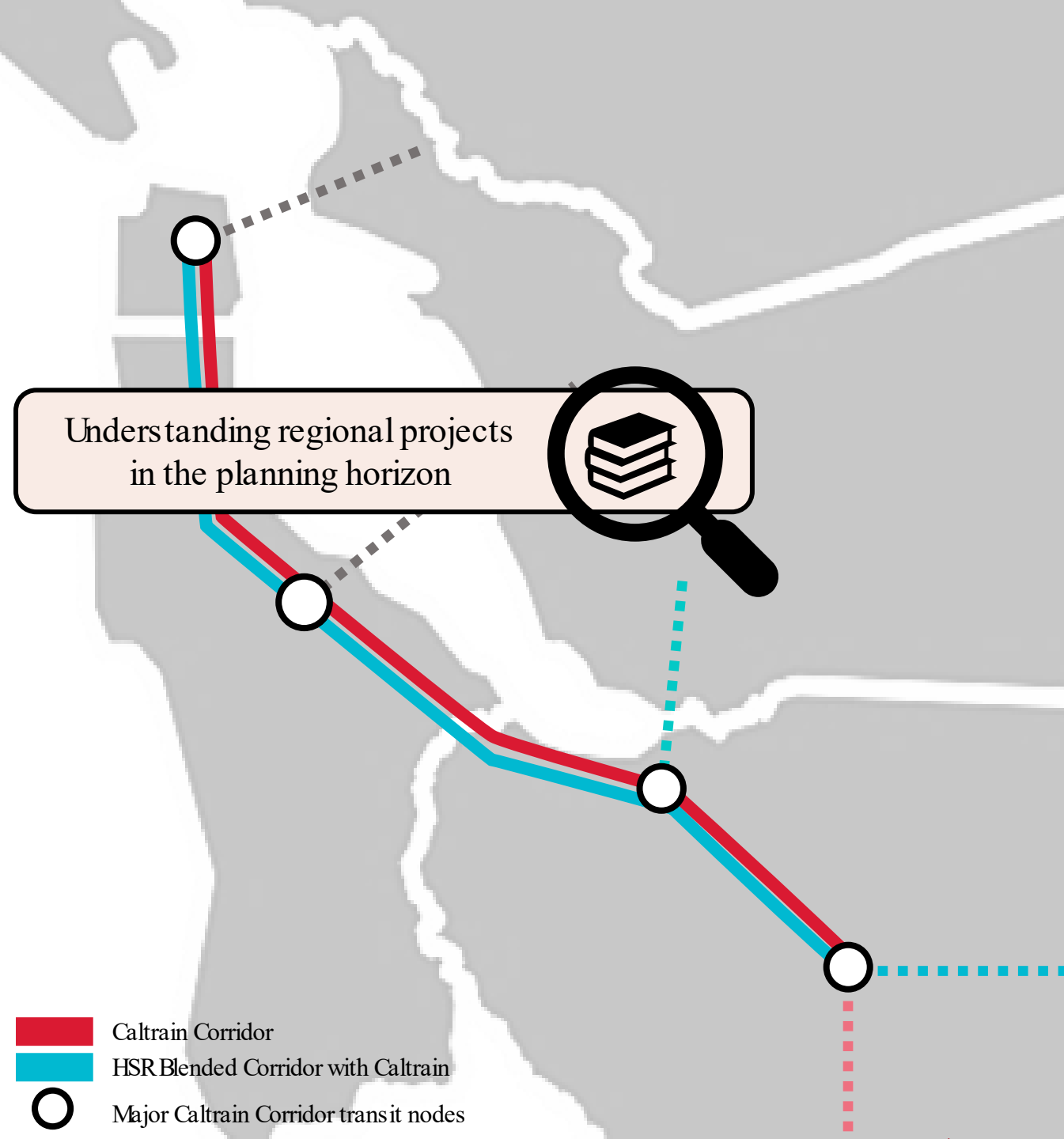
\* Fiscal Years

- Peer agency CIPs having planning horizons that range from two to twenty years
- Regardless of their span, CIPs share a common purpose:  
They establish an agency's portfolio of key investments along with the resources that will support them



# Regional Network

- Understanding which regional projects will be in place by the end of the planning horizon.
- Caltrain does not control most of these regional projects, but they might impact the organization's resources.

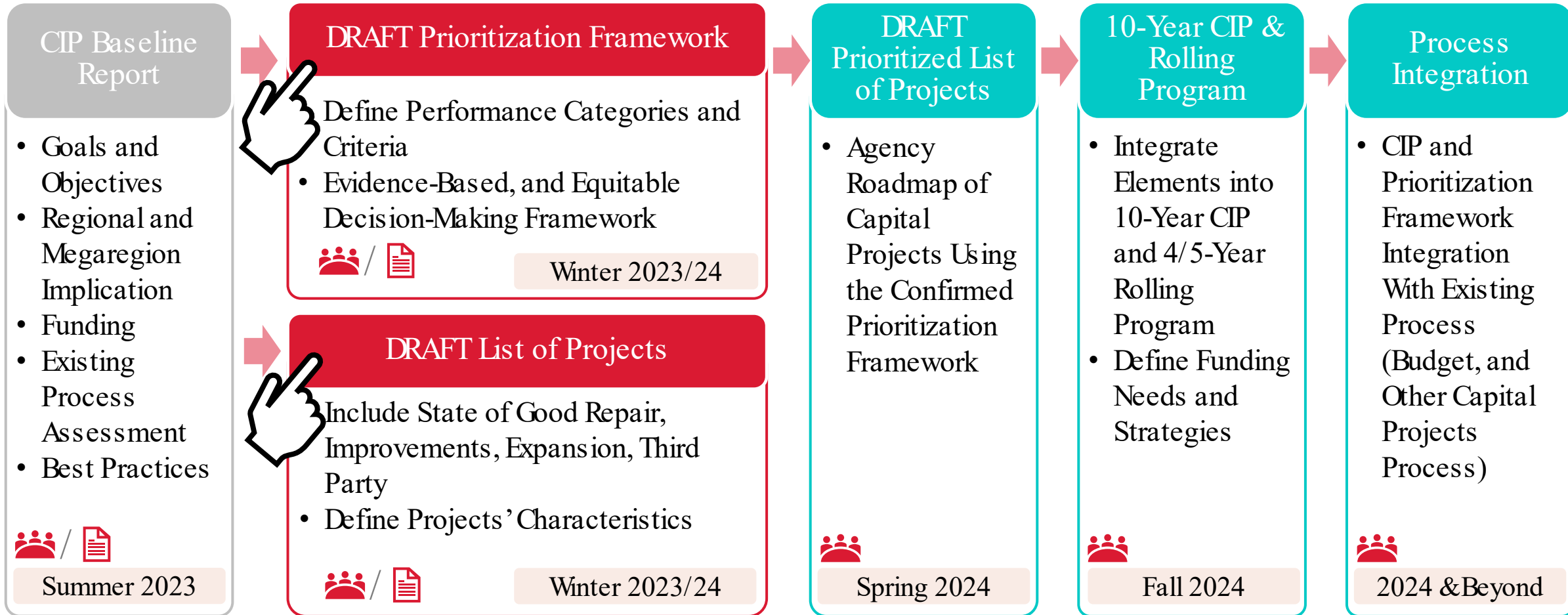


# Leveraging the CIP

1. Transitioning the call for projects that starts from scratch to pulling from a list of identified projects and funding needs
2. Having capital program planning and management tools in one easily accessible and centralized platform
3. Anticipating contingency assumptions and needs to improve project cost estimating
