# Project Goals

- Improve safety
- Improve Caltrain operation
- Improve accessibility for emergency vehicles
- Improve pedestrian and bicycle circulation
- Improve vehicular circulation
- Better accommodate future traffic growth
- Reduce noise in the project vicinity

# Project Elements

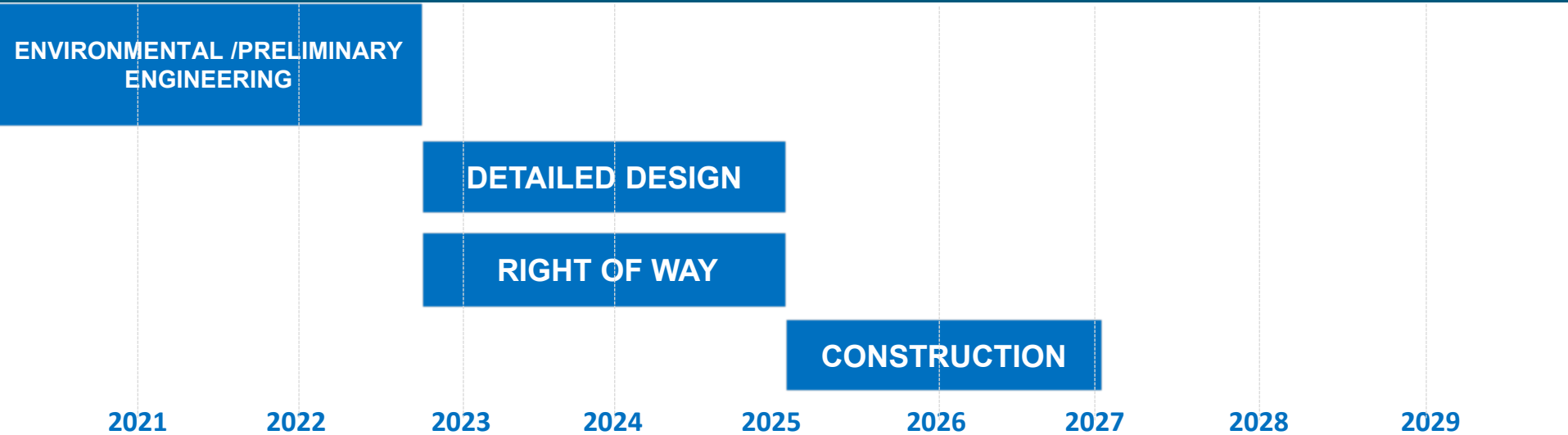
- Depress Rengstorff Avenue/Central Expressway intersection and build an undercrossing
- Build railroad and pedestrian bridges
- Build retaining walls
- Maintain Caltrain tracks at existing elevation

- Final design consultant selection – Completed
- Selection of CMGC Contractor – in Progress
- Public engagement - Ongoing

# Funding Commitments

## VTA

Final Design - \$18.5 million

Right of Way - \$23.5 million

## City of Mountain View

Final Design - \$1.5 million

Right of Way - \$6.5 million

Total Current Funding Commitment - **\$50 million**



# Design Services Procurement

- On June 15, 2023, JPB issued an RFP for Final Design Services
- Two firms submitted proposals:
  - AECOM Technical Services, Inc.
  - Stantec Consulting Services, Inc.
- Proposals were evaluated, scored and ranked
  - AECOM was selected as the highest-ranked firm
    - Base pricing: \$11,043,811.88
    - Optional pricing: \$1,452,230.26

# Next Steps

- Provide Notice to Proceed to the Selected Final Design Consultant
- Select a CMGC Contractor
- Complete Final Design
- Begin Construction

# Staff Recommendations

1. Award a contract to AECOM Technical Services, Inc. of San Jose, California (AECOM) to provide Final Design Services for the Rengstorff Avenue Grade Separation Project (Project) for a not-to-exceed amount of **\$12,496,042.14**, consisting of **\$11,043,811.88** for the base contract and **\$1,452,230.26** for optional services.
2. Authorize the Executive Director or designee to execute a contract with AECOM in full conformity with the terms and conditions set forth in the solicitation documents and negotiated agreement, and in a form approved by legal counsel.
3. Authorize the Executive Director or designee to exercise options for performance of additional project-related engineering and design services by AECOM, if deemed in the best interest of the JPB.
