Project Benefits

- Improve access and service for all customers
- Improve Caltrain efficiency
- Reduce train delays
- Reduce operating costs





Scope

- 14 new accessible ramps (known as mini-highs) at 8 stations
- Work will include installation of the precast platforms and modifications as needed to the existing infrastructure
- Capitol, Blossom Hill, Morgan Hill, San Martin and Gilroy pending funding availability



Budget and Funding

- Total cost for 14 ramps \$4.186 million
- Funding:
 - TA \$1,963,825
 - Federal \$460,000
 - FY2025 Capital Budget \$1,762,000



Timeline

- Design phase: December 2022 to August 2023
- Bid and Award: September 2023 to January 2024
- Construction Starts: April/May 2024
- Construction Complete: Fall 2024



Construction Information

- Noise will be minimal. Note there will be some drilling into the existing platform
- Work will be done in such a way to minimize impacts to patrons
- Work at each station will take about a week
- Light equipment will be used as needed and will be positioned to minimize impact to surrounding area.
- Appropriate signage will be posted
