Project Purpose and Need

- Current dollar threshold for formal procurement process for public works projects is \$10,000.
- Current dollar threshold for formal procurement process for all other purchases is \$250,000.
- Staff expects the JPB will have greater need for a higher dollar threshold for public works projects along the Caltrain corridor when the JPB starts electrified revenue service.



Solution

- California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act under Public Contract Code § 22000 et seq., allows local agencies to replace their statutory public works bidding thresholds with higher thresholds under the following conditions:
 - 1. Opt-in to the requirements of the Act and become subject to the policy and procedures adopted by the California Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Commission;
 - 2. Inform the State Controller's Office of such election; and
 - 3. Establish informal bidding procedures for public works contracts below CUPCCAA's formal bidding threshold (currently at \$200,000 or less).



Next Steps After Board Adoption of CUPCCAA

- 1. Inform the CA State Controller Office of the JPB's election to be subjected to the CUPCCAA policy and procedures as established by the Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Commission.
- 2. Update the Agency's Procurement Manual based on the CUPCCAA policy and procedures, and the Board adopted Ordinance, which established informal bidding procedures for public works contracting process.
- 3. Return in the Spring for Board consideration of revision to the Small Business Enterprise Preference Policy



Budget Impact

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Staff Recommendation

- Adopt a resolution pursuant to the provisions of the Public Contract Code § 22030, voluntarily making the JPB subject to the CUPCCAA, and to the California Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Commission's policies and procedures
- **2. Direct the Executive Director** or designee to **notify the State Controller's Office** of this election.
- **3. Adopt a resolution** directing staff **to revise the JPB Procurement Policy** to incorporate the requirements of CUPCCAA, and delegates authority to the Executive Director or designee to implement the Policy in accordance with applicable law and in furtherance of the Policy.
- 4. Adopt an Ordinance establishing informal bidding procedures for public works projects, as required by CUPCCAA.
