## CENTRAL EXPRESSWAY at THOMPSON AVENUE CLOSURE NOTICE | May 2024

### UPCOMING ACTIVITIES AND LANE CLOSURE

Beginning May 23 until June 14, Caltrain will be performing trenching work in Mountain View that will require intermittent lane closures and traffic control along Central Expressway near the intersection at Thompson Avenue. The temporary traffic controls are required due to trenching for a low-voltage connection, and construction equipment being utilized along the Caltrain right-of-way. **Work hours will be Thursday May 23 until Friday June 14 from 9 am to 3 pm. Traffic will be maintained in both directions.**

Construction signs, illuminated directional signs and flaggers will direct vehicles through the intersection during construction activities. Maps of the traffic controls are provided at the end of this notice for vehicle traffic.

### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

During the closure, crews will be digging a trench for a low voltage connection. Work will consist of excavation and repaving.

Caltrain will work with contractors to limit the impact to surrounding communities; however, some work must be performed in order to maintain regular Caltrain service. To mitigate noise and other impacts, the field team will utilize acoustical noise barrier blankets and will position lights away from residential and business areas.

Caltrain has established a dedicated project hotline and email for residents concerned about these potential impacts.

### PROJECT OVERVIEW

Over the last decade, Caltrain has experienced a substantial increase in ridership and anticipates further increases in ridership demand as the Bay Area's population grows. Caltrain Electrification, scheduled to be operational by 2024, will electrify and upgrade the performance, operating efficiency, capacity, safety and reliability of Caltrain's commuter rail service.

Caltrain electrification is a key component of the Caltrain Modernization Program and consists of replacing diesel-hauled with an electric train system for services between Fourth and King Street Station in San Francisco and the Tamien Station in San Jose. The project will include the installation of new electrical infrastructure and the purchase of electric trains.
