Background

- In 2017, the Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board (JPB) entered a contract with moovel North America LLC to provide a Mobile Ticketing Solution for Caltrain.
- This system supports a proof-of-payment fare enforcement model.
- Since its inception, the contract has undergone several amendments, including the addition of features such as parking capabilities and QR code validation.
- The JPB desires to discontinue this mobile ticketing solution once the Clipper Next Generation is launched, which is delayed into 2025.



Single Source Amendment Process

- Staff is seeking to amend the current contract with moovel to extend the contract term by 12 months, through October 31, 2025.
- The amendment will also increase the contract value by \$574,245, raising the total all-inclusive sum to \$2,255,851.
- This extension will ensure continued service until the Clipper Next Generation system is fully deployed, which is planned in the first half of calendar year 2025.
- Due to the proprietary nature of the current solution and the limited time frame to make any changes to our current solution, staff recommends a single source procurement which allows for additional time to strategize on any future parking payment solutions.

Budget Impact

Funds to support the contract will be included in the FY25 budget amendment being brought to the Board in December.





Proposed Motion

- 1. Authorize the contract amendment with moovel North America LLC to extend the term through October 31, 2025, and increase the total all-inclusive sum by \$574,245 for a new total, all-inclusive sum from \$1,681,606 to \$2,255,851.
- 2. Authorize the Executive Director or designee to execute the contract amendment, and any related documents necessary to implement the terms of the contract, as amended, in a form approved by legal counsel.
