 - California High Speed Rail Authority (CHSRA)
- Agreement covers pre-environmental and environmental phases of the project
- Agreement is interim in nature to be replaced by long-term governance organization currently being studied




Challenge


- Partners have successfully developed a vision for the future Diridon Station
- Current focus on turning the vision into a feasible project and setting a course to delivery
- Efforts on a mega regional transit project will need a solid delivery organization with champions and strong partnerships to reach its goals
- Accountability has not been clear to date and progress has been slow (existing agreement does not address accountability)
- Current project organization is unable to meet aggressive project milestones
- A new project delivery organization is currently being studied by the partner agencies

Highlights

- Sets up Project Steering Committee comprised of partner agency appointees to drive project
- Empowers Steering Committee while preserving partner agency authority to object
- Dispute resolution defined
- Partner agencies' roles and responsibilities defined
- Term for up to 4 years which covers pre-environmental and environmental phases of work
- Agreement is interim and will be replaced by future delivery organization
