# CALTRAIN RAIL CORRIDOR USE POLICY DECISION-MAKING FRAMEWORK

**OVERVIEW** 

The Rail Corridor Use Policy Review is used to determine if a proposed use of JPB property is compatible with the railroad's current and future needs.

### APPLICATION RECEIVED

Staff receive an application or request to discuss a proposed use for JPB property.

#### PRELIMINARY REVIEW

Staff compare the proposed use **location**, **type**, and **duration** to RCUP maps to determine in which **Property Use Zones** (PUZs) it is located and whether the proposed use aligns with **alowable uses**.

## PRELIMINARY USE COMPATIBILITY DETERMINATION

If the proposed use is among allowable uses for relevant PUZs, the project is **preliminarily compatible**. Staff conduct further review.

If not, the project is **preliminarily incompatible**. Staff work with applicant to determine if changes to the project would affect this determination. If so, applicant may submit a revised application.

### FINAL USE COMPATIBILITY DETERMINATION

Staff check station compatibility and TOD Policy alignment, as needed, and reach a final compatibility determination.

### **COMPATIBLE**

Staff complete the rest of the Property Access Agrement review and approval process, which must be completed before the Agreement can be granted.

#### **INCOMPATIBLE**

If desired, applicants may appeal an incompatibility determination by submitting a **Use Variance** application. Staff review the Use Variance materials and issue a Staff Recommendation for Board approval.
