



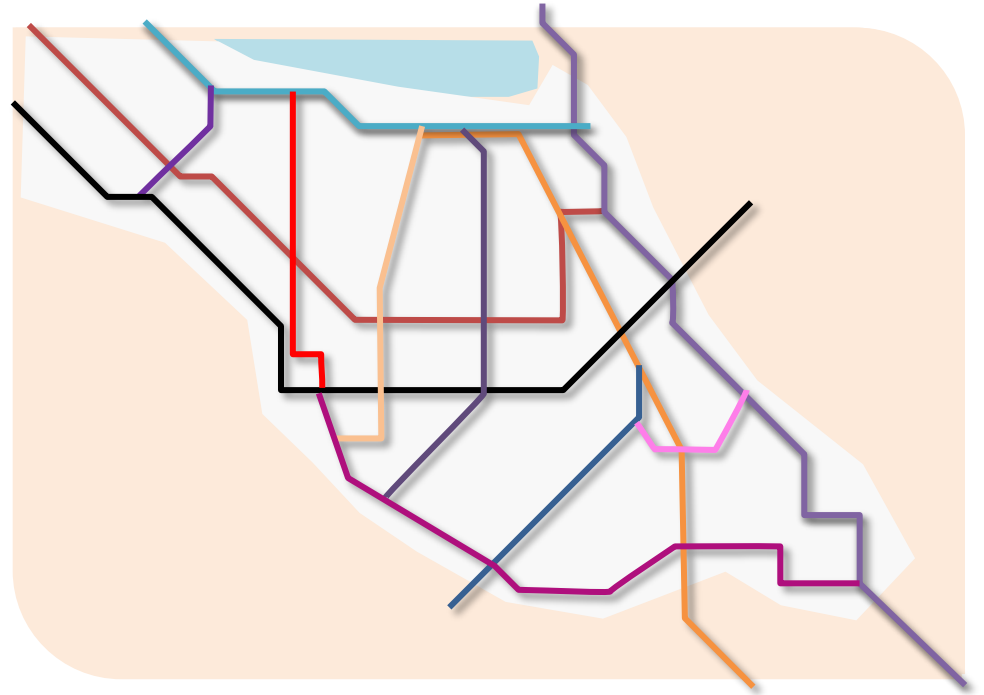

Vision | Bicycle Superhighways

- Routes separated mainly from automobiles – 17 candidate corridors
- High-quality, joyful, connections throughout County
- Builds on existing trail networks
- Includes on-street bikeways currently being planned by local agencies



What is a bike superhighway

Guideline	Description
Accessible	Backbone of regional bicycle network
Direct	Connect key destinations with few detours and stops
Dedicated	Separated from vehicular traffic
Low-Effort	Limited interruptions and low grades
Attractive	Positive and safe user experience; high quality materials and amenities

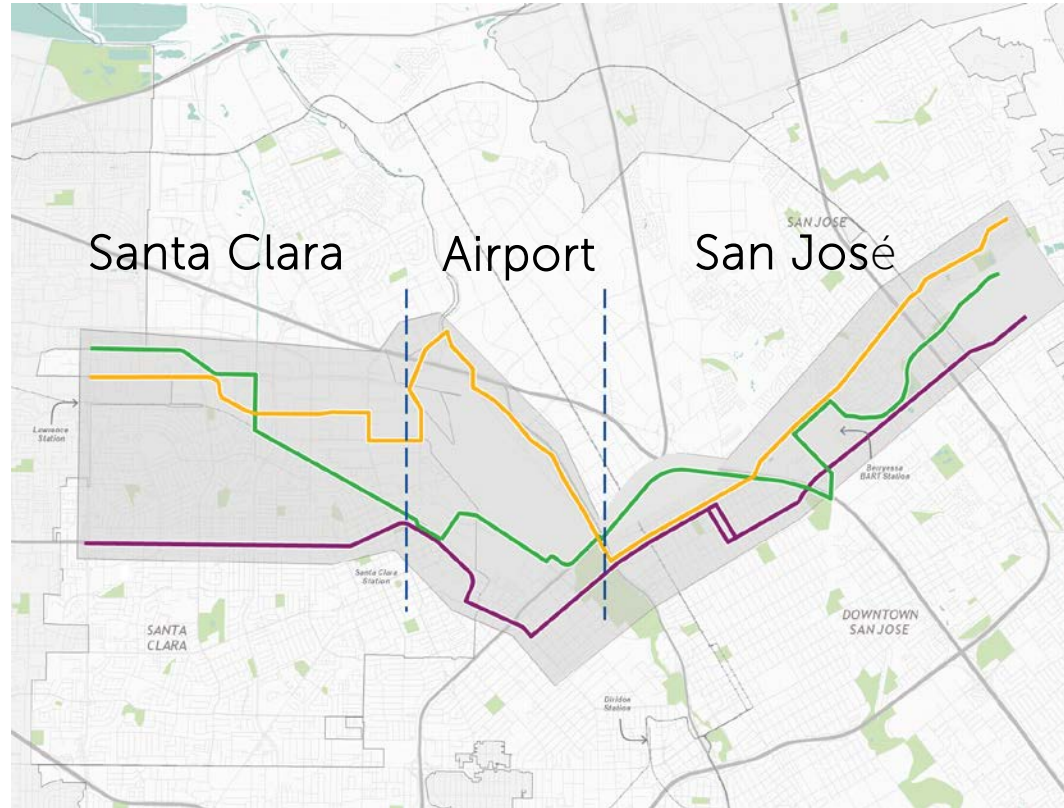

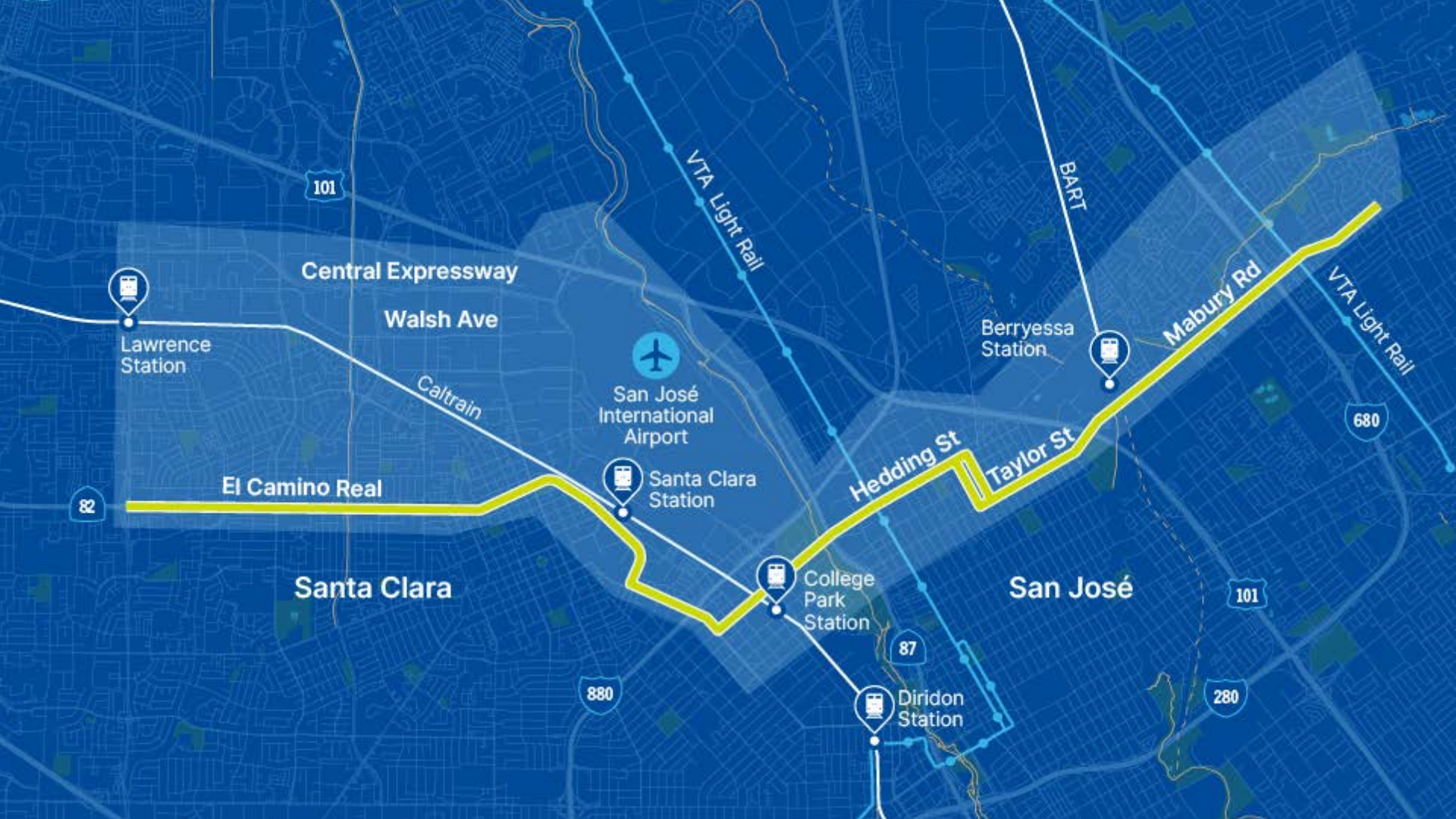

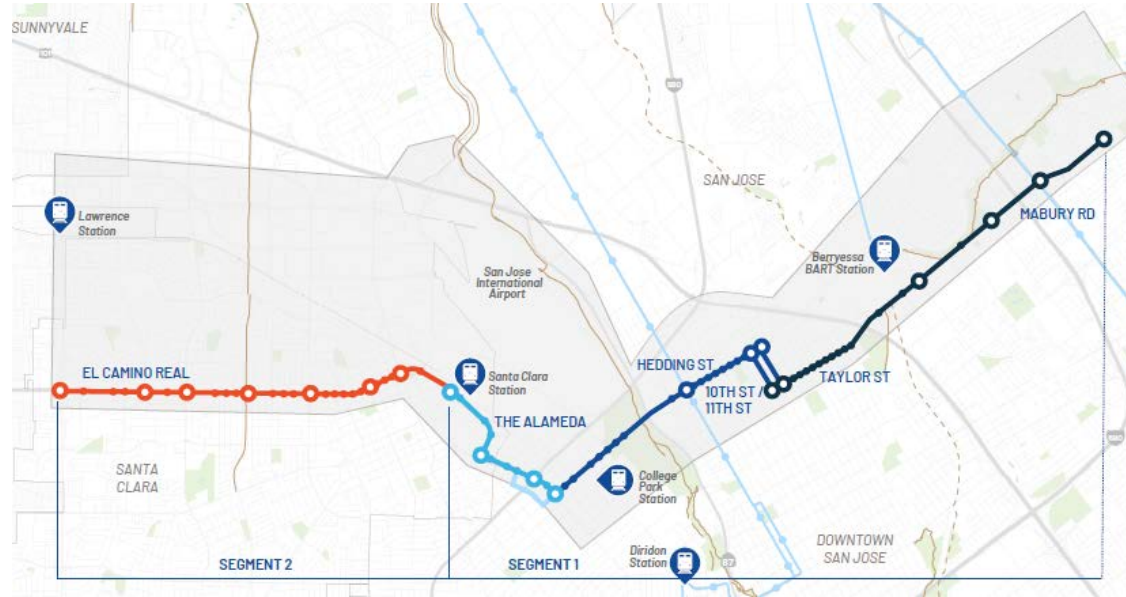

 - 2) Commercial Connectivity: El Camino Real to Santa Clara Transit Center

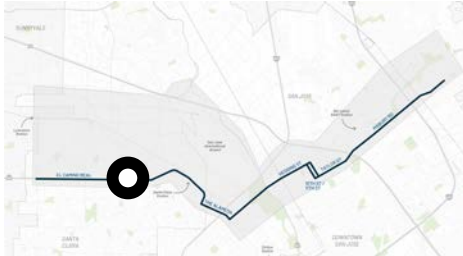

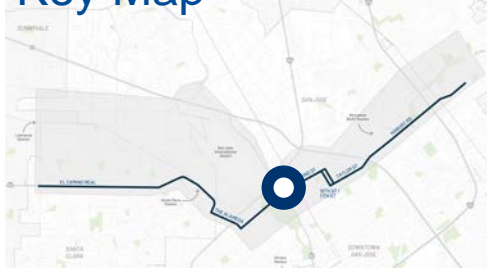
